TRANSPORT GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

How to reach the Dormitory/University from the Airport?



There are two different transport methods we would recommend to our International Students:

1. Taxi (quick and hassle free)

2. Public transport (budget friendly)

If you choose to travel by taxi, you can show the following addresses to your cab driver:

- 1. For the International Office: Eti, Celal Bayar Blv. No:88, 06570 Çankaya/Ankara.
- 2.For the Dormitory (inside the main campus of Ankara Medipol University): Hacı Bayram, Talatpaşa Blv No: 4, 06050 Altındağ/Ankara



If you choose to travel by public transport we will provide you with detailed steps below so your journey can be pleasant and stress-free.

- 1. Once you exit the Airport, you will take a left and look for the '**Ankara/Belko Air**' bus. This bus will take you to the Ankara Train Station (Ankara Gar). The journey will take around one hour and you will pay with cash. Please visit the following website to see the latest prices, https://www.ankaraair.com/en/hizmetnoktalari.
- 2. Alternatively, you can find the bus station for the **EGO** bus numbered **442** in the same area. This bus arrives every 45-60 minutes and will also take you to the Ankara Train Station. Once you exit the bus at the Train Station bus stop, you will walk 90 meters to your left until you reach the main campus of Ankara Medipol University where the dormitories are (boys and girls).

The International Office is on the other side of the Train Station. You can cross the Train Station and find Anafartalar Campus of our University on your left. The International Office is on the first floor of this campus.

We would advise all International Students who are travelling to Turkey for the first time to download offline Google Maps along with offline Google Translate (if you do not speak the local language). We wish you a pleasant journey.
